

THE SWISS CHALET – HOME AWAY FROM HOME

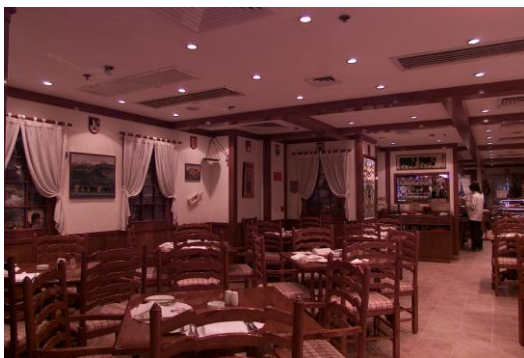
